

Ad-hoc General Education Policy Review Committee

The AASCU report of November 2006 pointed out a number of problems with the General Degree Requirements (GDRs). The Summer General Education Research Team was charged to research the literature of general education and identify several general education models that might work at UWSP. Their report, dated August 15, 2007, provides some recommendations for UWSP and may be used as the basis for the deliberations of the General Education Program (GEP)

Therefore, the Academic Affairs Committee recommends the formation of a two-year ad-hoc General Education Policy Review Committee.

Guidelines:

As a community of scholars, we value the input of all members of UWSP in reviewing and revising our General Education curriculum. To that extent, we encourage you to embrace the following guidelines:

- Open communication with all faculty and staff during the process
- Opportunities for input from all parts of the campus
- Honest and fair consideration of recommendations and suggestions

Composition: (10 member committee)

- 1 Member from the Academic Affairs Committee
- 1 Member from the Assessment Subcommittee
- 1 Member from the GDR Subcommittee
- 4 At large members from nominated faculty/staff (1 member from each College)
- 1 Member of Full-Time Academic Advising Staff
- 2 Students

Charge to the Committee:

- Articulate the mission of the General Education Program (GEP) at UWSP
- Identify the General Education model (core, distribution, decentralized) that UWSP will follow
- Develop the Explicit Goals and Learning Objectives of the General Education Program (GEP) at UWSP
- Specify Measurable Outcomes of the GEP at UWSP
- Develop the General Education Program (GEP) which should include creating clear criteria for meeting the learning objectives (for example: criteria for course approval)
- Develop an appropriate title for the General Education Program (GEP) that focuses on the value of the GEP
- Determine the advisability of appointing a Director of General Education at UWSP

Timeline:

The process of the Review of General Education at UWSP is an ongoing cyclical process.

- Mission and General Education Learning Objectives by March 2008
- General Education Program finished by March 2009
- General Education courses by March 2010
- Freshmen enrolling in UWSP in Fall 2010 to begin the new GEP

Composition

Members from each committee/subcommittee will be chosen by that body (total of three).

The full-time Academic Advisor will be chosen by the Advisors (total of one).

The students chosen by SGA (total of two).

The four at large members (one from each college) will be chosen by the members of the Academic Affairs Committee (AAC) from among either nominated or self-nominated candidates. Those candidates will submit a letter indicating why they desire to be on this ad hoc committee. Letters must be submitted within two weeks of the formal announcement and call for nominations made to the campus community.

Criteria for membership include:

A two-year commitment (2007-2009)

A commitment for summer 2008

Eligible to serve on the Senate
