### **Why Attend the Regional Conference?**

### **What make’s Let Me Learn the “tipping point?”**

The Let Me Learn Process, identified by John Gardner in 2007 as “the next ‘big idea’ for enabling student success” is an advanced learning system which relies upon

- a powerful theoretical basis of learning and metacognition,
- a set of practical tools (the Learning Connections Inventory, the Learner Profile, the Word Wall, the Metacognitive Drill, and the Strategy Card), and
- fifteen years of research and application in higher education that have yielded a documented record of improving student learning, retention, and persistence.

### **How Will I Benefit from Attending?**

You will learn how to use the Let Me Learn Process to

- understand your learners, advisees, counselees learning needs to a depth you have not reached before
- understand how to improve your students’ persistence and achievement, and
- build not just “classes” but learning communities and teams that achieve greater results.

### **Who Should Attend?**

Faculty and professional staff from all academic disciplines and student affairs units will benefit from attending, as well as administrators who have a commitment to leading their administrative units to achieve greater student success.
