

UWSP Chapter 245 Phi Kappa Phi Sophomore Scholarship



Amount: One - \$750 Scholarship

Deadline: Noon, October 13, 2011

Purpose: To recognize and honor students from any major who are achieving excellence in their academic work.

Eligibility: You are invited to apply for this \$750 scholarship if you—

- Have sophomore standing and have completed between 30 and 59 credits by September 1, 2011
- Have a Grade Point Average of 3.5 or better
- Have full-time student status at UW-Stevens Point
- Attend the initiation ceremony on November 13, 2011, unless studying abroad

To Apply:

1. Print and complete this application.
2. Supply an unofficial copy of your current UWSP transcript. You may supply a printout of your course history found on your myPoint page (academics tab) or a copy of your current transcript.
3. Respond to the writing prompt below. The essay is to be typed and single-spaced.
4. Turn in all materials by noon, Thursday, October 13, 2011, to Phi Kappa Phi, Student Affairs Office, 213 Old Main, UW-Stevens Point, Stevens Point, WI 54481.

Writing Prompt: Write an essay (not to exceed 500 words) that answers the question "Who am I?" Your audience includes members of the Phi Kappa Phi Executive Committee who are students, staff, and faculty of UWSP. In your essay, in support of your answer to "Who am I?," address at least two of the following aspects:

1. Characteristics and values that are important to you
2. A person or people who have influenced you and why
3. How you want to be perceived by others
4. How you think others perceive you

Please do not address items such as the music you like, the type of car you want to own, places you have traveled, your favorite pet, or the size of your family. Instead, focus on your internal values and what makes you who you are. For example, your essay's title could express the answer to "Who am I?"

Remember that an essay includes a controlling idea (a thesis or a theme), a title, a beginning, middle, and end, and is free of errors in format, grammar, spelling, and punctuation.

Essays will be rated on expressiveness of title, degree topic was covered, quality of thought and written expression, degree of creativity, appropriateness of format, and correctness of grammar, punctuation, and spelling.
