J & H Game Farm, a family-operated hunt club in the central part of the state, will co-host this learn-by-doing event tailored for new and novice hunters alike.

Participants will begin their day at 9:00 am in the clubhouse with refreshments and a review of firearm safety. From there, you will warm up your shooting on a beautiful walk-through-the woods sporting clays course. Sporting clays is a clay pigeon shooting game that simulates various bird hunting scenarios. This is fun way to practice and to enjoy time outdoors.

Hot sandwiches will be served at noon accompanied by J & H's homemade soup and famous cookies for dessert.
