LEAF and KEEP will be providing scholarships to the **first 12 teachers** who register for this course. **Scholarship recipients will only pay \$50.** Full cost this course is \$387.55 (\$372.55 tuition for UWSP Graduate credit and \$15 course materials). Once the scholarships are gone, teachers will need to pay the full \$387.55 course fee.

Participants are responsible for attending the course, creating and presenting curriculum integration plans during the course, and completing an assignment to be turned in by an arranged date after the course. The assignment is designed to have participants create a product that will support their efforts to integrate Biomass concepts into their classroom lessons.
