

Dedicating Timber Sale Income to a School Forest Budget
Example School Board Resolution

This is an example resolution to dedicate proceeds from school forests timber sales to a school forest account. The language is taken from a specific school district's resolution, but the references to the school district and school forest were removed.

“Proceeds received from the sale of school forest products, less deed restriction directives (if any), shall be placed into the ‘General Fund’ for the *district* and be designated to support the instruction programs in the *district's* school forest. The remaining proceeds at each fiscal year end shall be placed in the “Designated Fund Balance” Account and identified as such.”
