

We are looking for a mono shock to hold at least 250lbs that is cheap. Students tried one off a dirt bike, but it is too weak

What length eye to eye do you need? What was the spring rating on the shock that you used? I have a few places to check, but I need that information first.

Can the shock you have now be taken apart? If it can, go to McMaster.com and get a higher rate compression spring that will fit your shock. We actually had the opposite problem, too high of spring rate. Our shocks were able to be taken apart. We found a lighter spring at McMaster and that fixed our problem.

I have four VERY heavy duty springs that you can have if they would fit.

+/- 14" eye to eye. I'll have the kids check on taking it apart. They might dig the other shock out of the snow and try putting two on the swing arm.
