Description: Starting in Summer 2004, the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) will be moving away from the credit-based (6 credits or 180 clock hours) renewal system to a "Professional Development Plan" renewal system. The new system is based on the Wisconsin Standards with demonstrated knowledge, skills and dispositions for teaching, pupil services, and administration. However, those teachers, administrators, and pupil service personnel who were licensed under the "old" 6 credit renewal system can EITHER continue to renew in the same way as in past years OR move into the new Professional Development Plan system.

This course will assist with either the 6-credit renewal system or a transition to the new Professional Development Plan system.

EDUC790 ADMINISTRATIVE LEADERSHIP, DEVELOPMENT AND APPLICATION is designed for practicing administrators needing re-certification, or for those who want to maintain their Wisconsin administrative certification as they seek an administrative position. Course content will be tailored to the needs of the individual and their current educational position. Instruction is provided via on-site consultation, personal meetings, email access, and telephone.
