Relevant paper topics include (but not limited to) the doctrine of double effect, the distinction between combatant and non-combatant, supreme emergencies, proportionality, WMDs and other forms of unconventional warfare, and preventive and punitive actions in war.

Submission Deadline (postmark) for a paper of no more than 3,000 words:

**August 1, 2010**
