The proposal format is meant to be generally inclusive. Note that it would be <u>rare</u> for one proposal to meet all of the review criteria. Completed proposals should be between 200-300 words. Please be sensitive to the fact that reviewers may be outside of your discipline.

### **Expectations**

At the completion of the project, awardees will be expected to write a reflective article to be included in a composite FACETS publication, documenting actions, insights, findings, and/or any assessment data resulting from the project. Further, each award winner may be asked to present findings to a UWSP January Teaching Summit and/or in a national audience (publication or at a conference.

#### **Proposal Elements to Address**

- Focus/objectives of research or project
- Methodology or processes for achieving stated objectives
- Anticipated or possible outcomes
- Projected timeline

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# Proposals will be evaluated on the criteria listed below using a 3 to 0 scale. To warrant a rating of:

- 3=Idea is concise and succinct, and clearly stated; ideas track from one to the next; included jargon is defined.
- 2=Lacking in any above.
- 1=Stated ideas are unclear based on above.
- 0=Not applicable, not relevant to stated project, or not related to FACETS intentions or focuses.

Please note that we understand that the entire array of criteria **MAY NOT be applicable to each proposal.** 

### Criteria 1: Focus/objectives of research or project

- **⊃** Ideas are explicit, concise, succinct
- Objectives were clearly stated and understandable to the reader
- Objectives clearly reflect a relationship to the focus of the FACETS mission

### Criteria 2: Methodology for achieving possible outcomes

- Methodology matches stated objectives
- Proposed methodology appears explicit to the purposes of the project
- ⇒ Relevance of methodology was clear

### Criteria 3: Anticipated or possible outcomes of personal investigations

- → Project has potential to impact teaching, student learning, or revised course components
- Project has potential for scholarly impact

### Criteria 4: Projected Timeline

- → Project fits within time allotted
- **⊃** Plan for publication or presentation
